FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

As the parent/guardian, I understand:

- I am financially responsible for my student's account.
- The fee of \$1,150 offsets expenses of the group such as staffing (25% of the overall fee), show design, uniforms, transportation (busing, truck/trailer rental), equipment, contest entry fees, and other miscellaneous expenses incurred throughout the season.
- If my student's participation in this group is terminated, all monies collected or fundraised will remain with the Band Booster Club of Franklin Central High Schools plus payment in full.
- All previous fees must be paid in full or current in accordance with the band program handbook before my student can participate in this group.
- All fees are due in accordance with the payment schedule below.
- Delinquent accounts may be sent to collections. A fee of 33% will be added by the collection agency.

FCHS Winter Guard students are required to work group fundraisers to help fund the group's efforts. Ground fundraisers are extremely important. The money raised from these events allows us to keep your fees as reasonable as possible.

The boosters understand extenuating circumstances may arise regarding this financial agreement.
