Schedule

7:00a - Rehearsal (eat healthy food before)

8:15a - End of Rehearsal, load semi, eat (students allowed to leave FC during this break - must send parent email to Mr. Cooper)

*During this break - load uniform first, polish/prep instruments, put instrument NEXT to trailer, (shoes, hat box on bus with you), eat a healthy second breakfast, change into "under uniform" clothes.

10:00a - Board buses with everything you need

*Masks MUST be worn at all times on buses

10:10a - Depart for Welcome Stadium - Dayton, OH

12:25p - Arrive at the contest site, unload semi, have a quick snack, and get dressed into uniform

1:25p - Everyone in uniform and lined up

1:30p - Begin Transit to Warm-up (Area C)

1:40p - Band Warm-up

2:25p - Transit (pit transits at 2:10)

2:20p - Pit Report Time

2:35p - Band Staging

2:45p - Performance time! Go FLASHES!!!

After performance - Return to buses, meet with directors, load semi, and change. Relax and wait for dinner to be ready.

- you may want to bring a frisbee, cards, a book etc. We will have some time waiting in the park before/after dinner.

4:30p - Prelims AWARDS (DMs accept award)

4:45p - Dinner in Welcome Park (see map)

5:15p - Notification of evening schedule

** If we DO NOT MAKE FINALS - we will return home arriving at FC around 7:30p.

** If we DO make finals, we will perform sometime between 7:30p and 10:30p. Award will be at 10:45p, and arrival back to FC would be around 1:30a.

Show Day Reminders

- ALL STUDENTS ARE TO RIDE THE BUS TO AND FROM THE CONTEST.
- STUDENTS ARE NOT TO LEAVE FC (except briefly for the loading break as long as a parent has sent an email to Mr. Cooper)
- Have on your fitted shorts, fitted black undershirt, and long black socks to wear underneath your uniform as you board the bus from FC. Don't forget your marching/dance shoes and hat box either!
- Uniform changes occur only in the specified locations. Always have clothing on under your uniform and when changing. No visible undergarments at any time.
- Be respectful and follow instructions from chaperones, prop crew, all parents, staff, contest officials, and leaders.
- Represent your school, your community, and yourself with pride and dignity. Leave busses PERFECTLY clean.
- You are responsible for loading your own instrument and uniform, as well as a mouthpiece, extra reeds, and anything else you might need. DO NOT expect anyone to load/unload your equipment for you.
- Welcome Stadium requires guests to wear masks when buying/scanning tickets, in the restrooms, and in line for concessions

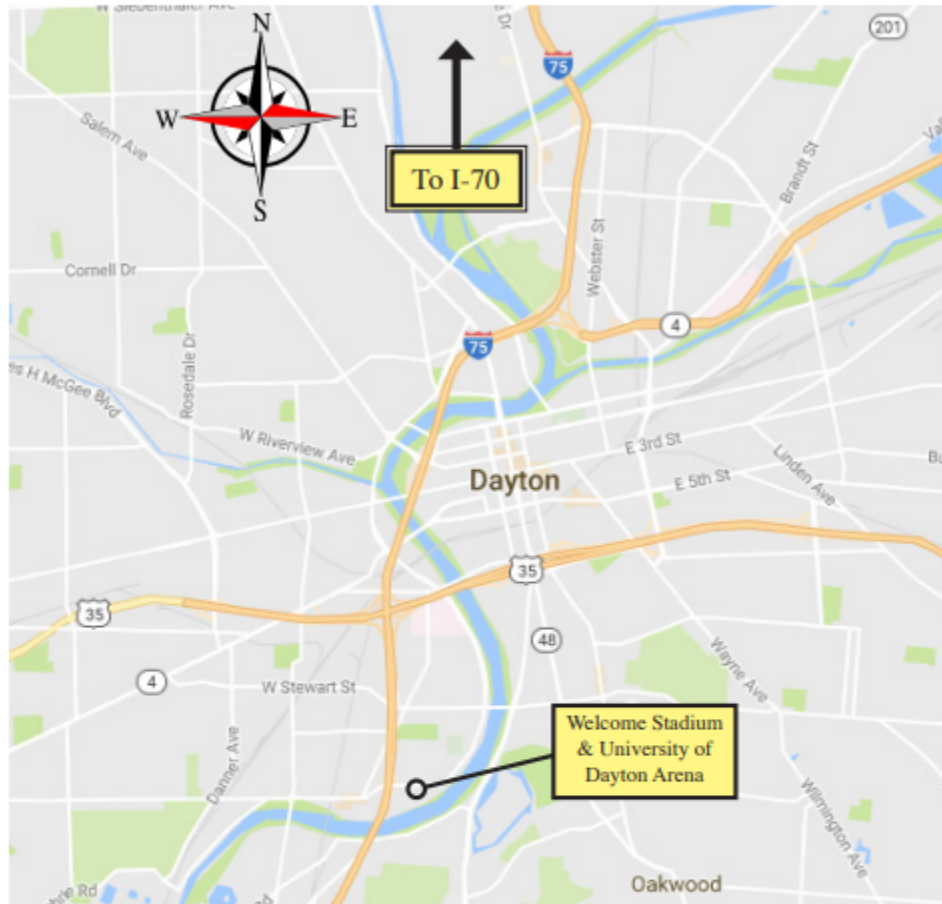

SITE OVERVIEW

September 18, 2021 - Welcome Stadium - Dayton, OH





From Indianapolis or Columbus: Take I-70 and exit onto I-75 S toward Dayton. Take exit 51 for S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd. Turn left onto S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd. The stadium will be on your left.

From Louisville: Take I-65 North. Take exit 137 and merge onto I-71 N. Keep right to stay on I-71 N. Take exit 17 to merge onto I-275 W toward I-75. Take exit 43B to merge onto I-75 N. Take exit 51 to merge onto S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd. The stadium will be on the left.

From Cleveland: Take I-90 W and continue onto I-71 S. Take exit 119B to merge onto I-270 W toward Dayton. Take exit 8 for I-70 W. Take exit 41 for OH-235/OH-4 toward Dayton. Turn left onto OH-235 S/OH-4 S/S Dayton Lakeview Rd. Keep left at the fork and follow signs for I-75 S/OH 4S and merge onto I-75 S. Take exit 51 for S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd. Turn left onto S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd. Stadium will be on your left.
